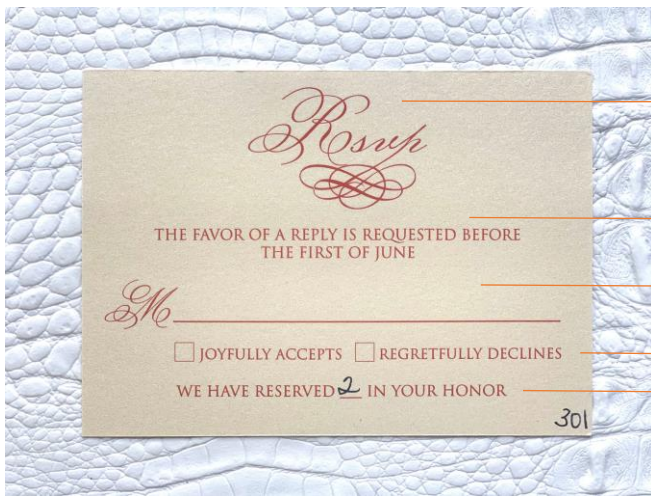


Ways for your guests to RSVP

- Option 1: Add a RSVP Card and RSVP return envelope to the wedding invitation for guests to return in the mail.
  - It is courteous to have the RSVP envelope equipped with a stamp for ease of returning the envelope and to increase RSVP responses
- Option 2: Have guest RSVP on your wedding website
  - Include the website address on a separate card and notify guests that they can RSVP on your website. Please note that some of your guests may not be internet savvy or have an email address and you could potentially leave out a percentage of your guests who are unable to meet your expectations.
- Option 3: Have guests RSVP via email to your wedding email address
  - Include the wedding email address on a separate card and notify guests to RSVP via email. Please note that some of your guests may not be internet savvy or have an email address and you could potentially leave out a percentage of your guests who are unable to meet your expectations.

- ✓ The Header
- ✓ Reply-By Date
- ✓ Response Options
- ✓ Number of guests attending
- ✓ What's for dinner? (optional)
- ✓ Ordered postage for envelopes (if necessary)
- ✓ The return addresses

**Quick Tip:** Sometimes guests do not write their names on the RSVP card. To avoid confusion, assign each RSVP card a number and write it discretely on the card to know who returned the RSVP card
