1. Bride's parents who are married and hosting

[Mother of the bride's name] and [Father of the bride's full name]

2. Bride's parents who are divorced and remarried are hosting

Mr. and Mrs. [Bride's stepfather]
and
Mr. and [Bride's father]
[the request line]
at the marriage of their daughter

3. Bride's mother and stepfather are hosting

[Mr. and Mrs. Bride's stepfather]
[the request line]
at the marriage of her daughter

4. Bride's only living parent is hosting (but want to recognize the deceased)

[bride's full name]
Daughter of [mother/father of the bride's full name] and the late [deceased parent's full name]
and
[groom's full name]
son of [groom's parents' names]
[the request line]

5. Groom's parents are hosting

Mr. and Mrs. [Groom's father name]
[the request line]
at the marriage of
Ms. [Miss] [Bride's Name]
to
their son
Mr. [Groom's Names]

6. Bride and groom's parents are hosting

Mr. and Mrs. [Bride's father name]
[the request line]
at the marriage of their daughter
[Bride's name]
to
[Groom's name]

son of
Mr. and Mrs. [Groom's father name]

7. Bride and Groom are hosting
[bride's full name] and [groom's full name]
[the request line]

8. Both families are hosting
Together with their families or something similar
[bride's full name] and [groom's full name]
